

MAGNET SCHOOL LOTTERY

The Cedar Rapids Community School District provides parents with two elementary magnet schools of choice: Johnson STEAM Academy (JSA) and Kenwood Leadership Academy (KLA). The district also provides a middle school option, Roosevelt Creative Corridor Business Academy (RCCBA). Magnet schools have a focused theme and are built on the foundation of the magnet school pillars: diversity, innovative curriculum and professional development, academic excellence, high quality instructional systems, and family and community partnerships. They use a "hands on - minds on" approach to learning while using state and district standards and vary the delivery of instruction by teaching the standards within a theme. Johnson STEAM Academy has a theme of STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics) and Kenwood Leadership Academy has a Leadership theme. Within the business theme, Roosevelt Creative Corridor Business Academy will follow three main pathways of learning: STEAM, Leadership & Entrepreneurship, and Global Systems.
